Graham ISD Calls Nov. 3 Bond Election

The Graham ISD Board of Trustees called a single-proposition bond election, known as Proposition A, for Nov. 3. Graham ISD's last voter-approved bond election was 19 years ago.

PROP A

Prop A is a \$60 million single-proposition bond package to address facilities and systems, including:



New (Grades 1-5) Elementary School

to replace Crestview & Woodland.
(projected to open in the fall of 2029)

Safety & Security Projects

at Pioneer Elementary, Graham Junior High and Graham High School.



Accessibility & Renovation Projects

at Pioneer Elementary, Graham Junior High and Graham High School; also provide updated dressing and locker room facilities for female students.

Career & Technical Education Projects

Renovate and equip CTE facilities for programs such as welding, agriculture, and culinary arts.



50+ Member Facility Planning Committee Recommends Bond Election

Projects in the November 2026 school bond proposition were recommended by students, parents, educators, taxpayers and community leaders on the Facility Planning Committee (FPC). The group spent most of the 2025-26 school year studying facilities, touring schools and prioritizing projects. They recommended a Long-Range Facility Plan that was approved by Trustees on August 11.

Elementary Consolidation Addresses Aging Facilities And Annual Operating Budget

Student enrollment growth has been declining slightly year after year as GISD graduates larger senior classes than incoming Pre-K or Kindergarten classes. Buildings currently separate students/staff in elementary grade levels, continue to age, and are under capacity.

GISD currently operates three elementary campuses and is proposing to reduce the number to two by building a new (grades 1-5) school to replace Crestview and Woodland. Construction of this new approximately \$53 million school is less than the cost of renovating Crestview and Woodland (approximately \$69.3 million) and less than the cost of replacing both campuses (approximately \$84.1 million).

The new grades 1-5 campus will allow for curricular alignment and instructional collaboration and planning among teachers. The consolidation will not impact teacher jobs because the same number of students will be served at one campus instead of two.

Projected Tax Impact

Graham ISD's bond proposal projects a five-cent increase on the local tax rate.

GISD's financial advisor projects the bond proposal would cost the average GISD homeowner **less than \$3 more each month.**



Tax bills are frozen and limited to the frozen cap for residents who are 65+ and older who have filed for the homestead exemption and have not made significant improvements to their primary residence.
